- II. Systematic use of assessment strategies and measurement practices to obtain and provide feedback on student learning growth, attainment and wellbeing capabilities.
- III. The strategic direction and deployment of resources to create and reflect shared goals and values; high expectations; and a positive, safe and orderly learning environment.
- IV. Responsive, tiered and contextualised approaches and strong relationships to support student learning, wellbeing and inclusion.
- V. Activation of student voice and agency, including in leadership and learning, to strengthen students' participation and engagement in school.
